## HADRIAN COURSE LOCAL RULES

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS

Beyond all fences, walls, hedges and white posts marking the boundary of the course.

The beck to the left of the 1st fairway, the car park and the fence behind the 8th green.

### 2. BUNKERS (rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions.

### 3. FIXTURES (rule 24-2)

Any temporary fences, seats, waste bins, sprinkler heads, holemarkers, ballwashers, huts and pathways are immovable objects.

### 4. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (rule 25)

Any deep vehicle tracks or ruts caused by greenkeeping. Piles of grass cuttings left by and awaiting removal by greenkeepers. Any areas marked by white lines.

### 3. WATER HAZARDS (rule 26)

All water hazards are marked by yellow posts and lateral water hazards with red posts. Bridges over water hazards are deemed to be obstructions within the water hazard. A ball should be played from the bridge and the club may be grounded (rule 13-4).

### SAFETY

During thunder and lightening all players must mark their balls and leave the course immediately.  
You are responsible for your own health and safety and for others who may be affected by you while on the golf course. This includes not striking a ball that could endanger others, observing the local rules, using buggies responsibly and reporting anything dangerous you notice to the management.

### ETIQUETTE

- Always replace Divot Marks and repair Pitch marks
- Invite players behind through if there is one clear hole ahead
- Play without undue delay
- Rake bunkers after use
- Sharing of golf bags is not allowed
- Suitable dress is required on the course - (jeans, tracksuits, football stripes and swimwear are not permitted)
- Tailored shorts and socks are acceptable for gentlemen
- Gentlemen are required to wear shirts with collars
- Ladies are required to wear shirts with collars or sleeves
- Players are required to check in at reception before playing
- Failure to observe these rules may prevent you playing or could result in you being asked to leave the course without refund or green fees
